Descripción:	About the Organizer Jiangsu Inspection and Quarantine Institute of Quality (hereinafter referred to as JSIQ) was established in 2005 and affiliated with Nanjing Customs District, China. It has been organizing foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China. JSIQ is a scientific research institution engaged in quality research, international exchanges, comprehensive training and management consultation. It now has several departments namely Department of Research on Development, Department of International Exchanges and Cooperation, Department of Comprehensive Training, Department of Consultation on Quality and Department of Comprehensive Management. There are over 40 staff members working with this institution. JSIQ started to organize foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China since 2006, and has organized 302 programs successfully by the end of 2024. Over 9000 Customs officials, technicians and participants from other authorities of 153 countries and international organizations from five continents received training during these programs. The contents of training in programs organized by JSIQ focus on a variety of sectors including import and export commodity inspection, entry and exit animal and plant quarantine, entry and exit health quarantine, import and export food safety, Customs administration, standards, metrology, certification and accreditation, market supervision and intellectual property rights; the languages used include English, French, Russian, Mongolian, Lao, Arabic, Spanish, Portuguese and Cambodian. It thus has gained rich experience in foreign-aid training within customs system and achieved fruitful results thereof.
