Descripción:	About the Organizer China Meteorological Administration Training Centre (hereinafter referred to as: CMATC), a comprehensive, professional, high-level meteorological education and training institution established in 1955 that integrates CPC school, administration and meteorological professional continuing education, is a national base for high-level continuing education and on-the-job training in the meteorological sector. CMATC was recognized by the World Meteorological Organization as the WMO Beijing Regional Training Center (RTC-Beijing) in 2003 and was awarded the WMO/CGMS Virtual Laboratory of Excellence in 2007. Since 2003, CMATC has held 109 international training workshops for a total of 10,933 international participants from more than 170 countries and regions. Since 2020, CMATC have held 35 online courses enrolling 9739 international participants from 159 countries and regions. For 4 consecutive years since 2020, CMATC was acknowledged as the largest online training centre among all the 43 WMO centres. CMATC was granted as one of the most active regional training centres among all its WMO counterparts and recognized as the “trend setter” of distance training course on meteorology and “paragon for competency training”. CMATC will continue to perform its duties as a WMO RTC by organizing international training events in various fields with focuses on WMO priority areas, regional meteorological training needs and China's meteorological development priorities for developing and least developed countries to improve their meteorological services.

I. Main Training Contents

1. Module One: Climate Change and Ecosystem Fundamentals. Introduce the scientific principles of climate change, including greenhouse gas emissions, global warming, and extreme climate events; basic concepts and types of ecosystems, including the main features of terrestrial and marine ecosystems; the impact of climate change on ecosystems.

2. Module Two: Adaptive Strategies for Ecosystem Conservation. Introduce ecosystem restoration and reconstruction, including strategies and practical cases for restoring damaged ecosystems, nature-based solutions, and adaptive planning for ecosystem conservation.

3. Module Three: Policies and Regulations for Ecosystem Conservation. Introduce major policies and agreements at home and abroad for addressing climate change and ecosystem conservation, the process and methods of policy implementation and efficiency improvement, and the formulation and practical application of policies.

4. Module Four: Ecosystem Management Practices and Chinese Experience. Introduce technical methods for ecosystem monitoring and assessment, ecosystem management models, such as community participation practices, cross-departmental collaboration in ecosystem management, and practical experiences of China in the field of ecosystem conservation.

5. Module Five: Case Studies and Discussion. Introduce successful ecosystem conservation cases at home and abroad, and through exchange and discussion, analyze the challenges and opportunities faced by various countries in addressing climate change and ecosystem conservation, and share excellent practices from different countries.
