Descripción: **Mission of the Programme**

The Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Programme was launched in 2013 by the Hungarian Government with the aim of providing opportunities for international students to pursue their higher education studies in Hungary. The programme's core mission is to increase the number of international students in Hungary and encourage Hungarian higher education institutions to attract top international students.

Students can also apply for a one-year Hungarian language preparatory training course, after which they can pursue their higher education studies in the Hungarian language. Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holders are encouraged to focus on their academic advancement during their stay in Hungary, as all their tuition fees are covered, and their accommodation and living costs are supported as well. Upon finishing their studies, a European degree in hand provides graduates with a wide range of opportunities in the global job market. During the past decade, the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship programme has become a brand in its own right, demonstrating Hungary's commitment to supporting international education and cultural exchange. The programme's success is a testament to the quality and competitiveness of Hungarian higher education and the country's commitment to science diplomacy.

Study Levels

Stipendium Hungaricum scholarships are available for bachelor's, master's, one-tier master's, doctoral, non-degree programmes (preparatory courses) and postgraduate specialist training courses. Please note that this Call for Application is for bachelor's, master's, one-tier master's, non-degree programmes and postgraduate specialist training courses only.

Note about one-tier master's programmes and postgraduate specialist training courses:

In the Hungarian education system, one-tier master's programmes cover both the bachelor and the master level of studies; therefore, it is an undivided master's programme that results in a master's degree. These one-tier programmes are offered in specific study fields such as general medicine, pharmacy, dentistry, architecture, law, veterinary surgery, forestry engineering,

etc.

Postgraduate specialist training courses provide the opportunity to obtain a specialized qualification after a bachelor's or master's degree. Preparatory courses are not available for postgraduate specialist training courses.

Study Modes

Both full-degree and partial (exchange) study modes are available in accordance with the relevant bilateral educational cooperation agreement. Full degree programmes lead to a bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree. One-year programmes do not lead to a degree but provide a preparatory course before a degree programme.

Partial (exchange) studies are one- or two-semester-long exchange studies. If the partial (exchange) studies are part of the student's degree studies in their sending higher education institutions, those who apply for partial (exchange) studies must be registered in and have student status at a higher education institution operating outside of Hungary. In this case, applicants can only apply to those study levels they are attending at their sending, home institutions. In case partial studies are not part of the student's degree studies in their sending higher education institutions, a student status at a higher education institution operating outside of Hungary is unnecessary.

Partial (exchange) studies are available for up to one academic year, must be completed by 30 June and cannot be extended. Please be extra cautious when selecting your preferred study programmes in the online application system as most of the study programmes are offered as both full degree and partial study programmes; therefore, those programmes appear twice. Please make sure that you select the programme marked with the study mode you desire because it is impossible to change the study mode after the application deadline.

Available Host Institutions and Study Programmes

At these levels, 30 Hungarian higher education institutions are engaged in the Stipendium Hungaricum Programme for the 2026/2027 academic year, with about 800 study programmes in foreign languages (taught mainly in the English language). Study programmes are generally available in English and Hungarian, with some programmes offered in German and French as well.

The available study programmes and host institutions are accessible through the online application system (<https://apply.stipendiumhungaricum.hu/>). Please note that you can only apply for these study programmes within the framework of the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Programme.

Applicants are eligible to apply only for those scholarship types and study fields that are determined in the educational cooperation programmes in effect between Hungary and the specific Sending Partner. For citizens of some countries, it is possible to apply within several frameworks. They must carefully select the courses included in their chosen framework.

Requisitos: **Eligible Sending Partners**

The Stipendium Hungaricum Programme is based on effective bilateral educational cooperation agreements between the Hungarian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade or its legal predecessor as regards the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Programme, the Ministry of Human Capacities, and the partner's Ministry responsible for higher education. Applications will be considered eligible only if the responsible authorities of the Sending Partner nominate the applicant.

Non-eligibility

Applications will not be considered in the following cases:

- Hungarian citizens (including those with dual citizenships), stateless persons, refugees, protected individuals, asylum-seekers, admitted individuals, or persons who have a longterm residence status or do not fall within the scope of Section 39 (1) a) of the Higher Education Act Please note that this requirement is not only for applicants but for Scholarship Holders as well; it means that, e.g., if you obtain Hungarian citizenship or refugee status during your studies in Hungary, you automatically lose your scholarship status.
- Applicants with citizenship different from the sending country/territory. For example, only Argentinian citizens can apply through the Argentinian Sending Partner,
- Applicants born after 31 August 2008 (= applicants under 18 years old as of 31 August 2026 except applicants applying for Dance study programmes,
- Applicants applying for a doctoral programme within the SH programme in the same application round,
- Applicants who are registered self-financed / fee-paying students of a Hungarian higher education institution at the time of the application deadline AND who are applying for a study level below their self-financed studies. It means that self-financed master students of a Hungarian higher education institution cannot apply for bachelor's studies.
- Those former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders who were awarded scholarships for full degree studies and who
- are now re-applying for full degree or partial (exchange) studies in the same cycle or lower level of education (non degree studies, bachelor, master, one-

tier master level) –(therefore, those Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders can apply for the programme who wish to continue their studies at a higher level of education, e.g., bachelor Scholarship Holders can apply for master studies!)

- are now re-applying for the programme for any cycles of education while they still have a scholarship status at the time of application (unless they withdraw their former scholarship before the application deadline) and will not receive their degree until 31 August 2026
- have postponed the start date of their scholarship studies and did not withdraw their scholarship before the current application deadline.
- Those former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders who were awarded scholarships for partial (exchange) studies and who
- are now re-applying for partial (exchange) studies in the same cycle or lower level of education (non-degree studies, bachelor, master, one-tier master level) –(therefore, those Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders can apply for a higher level of education, e.g. former bachelor Scholarship Holders can apply for master partial (exchange) studies if they are now master students in their home countries!)
- Those former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders who were awarded scholarships in the 2023/24, 2024/25, or 2025/26 application round, but after accepting their scholarship, did not travel to Hungary and did not start their studies, nor did they notify Tempus Public Foundation of this fact until 15 October. This clause also applies to those former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders who have postponed their scholarship awarded in the 2022/23, 2023/24 or 2024/25 application round but did not travel to Hungary and did not start their studies next year, nor did they notify Tempus Public Foundation of this fact until 15 October (in the case of a one-semester postponement until 15 January).

Please note that it is only possible to re-apply for full degree scholarship studies in the same education cycle if the former Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holder was previously awarded the scholarship for partial (exchange) studies. Even in this case, the length of the full degree scholarship shall be reduced by the length of the previous partial (exchange) studies.

Important note for self-financed students already studying in Hungary:

Those applicants who are registered self-financed / fee-paying students of a Hungarian higher education institution at the time of the application deadline AND who are now applying for the same study level are only eligible to apply for the Stipendium Hungaricum programme if

- they are recommended by their Hungarian host universities where they are studying at the time of application, AND
- if their cumulative, corrected sum average (“összesített korrigált kreditindex”) is higher than the students’ average performance in the particular study programme (“szakátlag”).

For example, self-financed master’s students enrolled in Hungary can apply to

continue their studies with the scholarship on the same master's level only if they are recommended by their university and their cumulative, corrected sum average is above average. Please see further details about the optional application documents in Section 3.2.3.(ver documento convocatoria)of the Call for Application. Applicants for the Students at Risk Subprogramme are requested to read point 4 carefully, which contains the special conditions applicable to them.

Order of Selected Study Programmes

In addition to the first choice of study programme, there is an opportunity to apply for an additional, second study programme. Therefore, each applicant can apply for up to TWO different study programmes in order of preference. These two study programmes can be both at the same Host Institution or different Host Institutions; it is the applicants' decision. The order of preference is essential. During the application process, the first selection and examination procedure will be conducted for the study programmes selected as the applicants' primary choices. These primary choices will be considered first. In this way, the chances of receiving the scholarship are relatively higher for the study programmes selected as primary choices. Please note that the applicant cannot modify the selected programmes (including the study language and the study model!) and the order of preference after the application deadline! We strongly advise all applicants to carefully check the minimum entry requirements of the study programmes and take time to decide on the order of preference. (To see the entry requirements, please click on the name of the study programme you selected in the application system.) We also highly encourage applicants to increase their chances of receiving the scholarship by applying for not only one but two study programmes in total.

Language of Study Programmes

Applicants are eligible to apply only if they meet the minimum language criteria set by the chosen Host Institution. Please visit the online application system (<https://apply.stipendiumhungaricum.hu/>) to see the exact language criteria for each study programme!

For Study Programmes taught in English and other foreign languages

- Full degree studies and partial (exchange) studies
- minimum level of knowledge - level of English proficiency determined by the Host Institution
- language preparatory year
- none

Study programmes taught in Hungarian language

- applicants with at least an intermediate (B2) level of Hungarian language knowledge
- minimum level of knowledge - level of Hungarian proficiency determined by the Host Institution

- language preparatory year - none if the language certificate is uploaded
- applicants with basic or no Hungarian language knowledge - **Only for full degree studies** (unavailable for partial exchange studies)
- minimum level of knowledge - level of English proficiency determined by the Host Institution usually basic level
- language preparatory year - yes, obligatory one-year Hungarian language preparatory course

Note about language choice in the online application system:

By default, the online application system lists the study programmes as foreign language programmes. However, if you wish to start your studies at a full degree programme in Hungarian, you need to answer the question “Would you like to perform your studies in Hungarian at the selected full degree programme?” on the application form with “Yes, I would like to perform my studies in Hungarian at the selected full degree programme.” If you select this, you can only be considered for the selected full degree programme in the Hungarian language; therefore, please be cautious when filling out the online application form. If you apply for a Preparatory course in Hungarian language, please select the following answer: “No, I would not like to study in Hungarian at my full degree programme.”

Studies in English or Other Foreign Languages

Students shall have a level of proficiency in the language of education as required by the Host Institution. The applicants must apply to the study programmes directly in the online application system

Studies in the Hungarian Language

Applicants who wish to study in the Hungarian language must have a sufficient language proficiency level. A copy of the proof of Hungarian as a foreign language knowledge must be uploaded as part of the application in the online system. The level of Hungarian language skills will be tested during institutional entrance examinations. Please note that if you apply only to Hungarian study programmes directly but fail the language test, you cannot be admitted anywhere.

Those applicants whose language skills are insufficient to complete their studies in Hungarian shall complete an obligatory one-year preparatory language course before starting their degree programmes. For this, the applicants are usually required to have at least a basic level of English proficiency. In the online application system, applicants must apply directly for the preparatory course (NOT for the degree programme they wish to start after the language preparatory year). To see all Hungarian language preparatory courses and entry requirements, please check the online application system (<https://apply.stipendiumhungaricum.hu/>)

Hungarian as a foreign language

In the first year of their studies, Scholarship Holders must attend the course

„Hungarian as a foreign language” offered by the host university and pass an exam at the end of the second semester (except Scholarship Holders studying in the Hungarian language). Scholarship holders who do not attend the course will not be able to receive the monthly stipend (mentioned at 1.3.) (ver documento convocatoria). The monthly stipend for students who take the course but fail to pass the exam will be reduced to 30,000 HUF/month.

Preparatory Courses and foundation semester/year

Besides full-degree programmes, full-time non-degree programmes are also available within the programme, in certain cases, for up to one year. Please read this section if you are applying for study programmes in the fields of music, engineering, computer science, and information technology. Preparatory courses are non-degree programmes before starting a bachelor- or master-level degree programme at a Host Institution (both with a scholarship).

Regarding the preparatory courses, applicants can ONLY apply to Hungarian language preparatory programmes. Even these preparatory courses can ONLY be applied to if the student wishes to continue his/her degree studies at a Hungarian language programme after the preparatory year. After completion, it is not possible to continue the studies in English or other foreign languages. Please see Section 2.5.2. (ver documento convocatoria) for further details about this.

However, ONLY in the case of English language full degree study programmes and ONLY in the fields of Engineering, Music and Dance or Computer Science and Information Technology, the Host institutions have the right to decide to admit the applicant for a foundation semester/year before they can start their full degree programmes. This decision is made during the institutional entrance examination process and is based on the applicant's professional evaluation. Therefore, applicants cannot directly apply for a foundation semester/year in English; it is always the Host Institutions' decision whether a professional preparation year is necessary.

Beneficios:

Provisions Covered by the Scholarship

Tuition-free education - exemption from the payment of tuition fee

Monthly stipend - non-degree, bachelor's, master's and one-tier master's level: monthly amount of HUF 43,700 (cca EUR2 110) contribution to the living expenses in Hungary for 12 months a year until the completion of studies

Accommodation contribution - free dormitory place (depending on institutional capacity) or a contribution of HUF 40,000/month (cca EUR 100) to accommodation costs for the whole duration of the scholarship period (Please note that if the student does not live in the dormitory, the HUF 40,000/month is a contribution to the rental costs, and in bigger cities –especially in the capital city –this contribution would not cover the full amount of rental costs.)

Medical insurance- health care services according to the relevant Hungarian

legislation (Act CXXII of 2019 on Entitlements to Social Security Benefits and Funding These Services) 3 and supplementary medical insurance for up to HUF 65,000 (cca EUR 165) a year/person

Please bear in mind that these provisions are only a contribution to the living expenses of the Scholarship Holders. It means that it does not fully cover all the living costs, and the students need to add their own financial resources to cover all living expenses in Hungary. 2) Application to Tempus Public Foundation

All applications shall be submitted through the online application system of Tempus Public Foundation. After registration, the applicants can access the application system and upload the required documents. Applications must be submitted; only saved applications will not be considered. Please note that no applications will be accepted without the online submission and after the deadline. No hard copies are required. A guide for the online system will be available to download from the <https://stipendiumhungaricum.hu/apply/> website.

The deadline for submitting the complete application: 15 January 2026, 2 p.m. (Central European Time)

A) Basic Application Documents

All of the following documents are compulsory and must be submitted to the online application system by all applicants by 15 January 2026, 2 p.m., except for the medical certificate which you must bring with you and present it during the compulsory medical examination in Hungary only if you are awarded a scholarship. Please note that only files with a maximum size of 4 MB can be uploaded to the system.

All documents that cannot be obtained or produced in the language of the selected study programme or in Hungarian must be translated, and the translations must be submitted together with a copy of the original document to the corresponding task in the online application system. Please note that in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in European Union law, you need to give your consents regarding data protection and accept our Privacy Notice in order to be able to submit your application. These consents appear in the system after registration, including the Privacy Notice (Annex 3).

1) Online application form:

- the applicants must fill out and save all requested information on the online application form in English.
- a recent photo of the applicant (taken not earlier than 2 years before the submission of the application).
- those who apply for partial (exchange) studies must clearly state the length (indicated in months) and start date (September or February) of the studies they apply for.

2) Motivation Letter:

- minimum 1 page, typed in Times New Roman 12
- point font size letters
- written in the language of the selected study programme or Hungarian.

3) Proof of language proficiency and translations in the language of the selected study programme or Hungarian:

- scanned copy of the original proof of language proficiency, with a minimum level determined by the Host Institution AND its translation - see section 2.5 (ver documento convocatoria) . for further details
- in case the student has completed his/her previous level of studies in the language of the selected study programme, proof can be uploaded about the fact that the language of education was the same as the language of the study programme that the applicant is now applying for
- translations must only be attached if the copy of the original document is not in the language of the selected study programme or Hungarian.

4) School certificates and their translations in the language of the selected

study programme or Hungarian:

- scanned copy of the original master degree certificate or equivalent AND its translation, partial (exchange) study programmes (if the partial studies are part of the student's degree studies in their sending higher education institutions or if the Hungarian host institution requires it –see Section 1.2.2) (ver documento convocatoria): scanned copy of the original certificate about student status issued by the current higher education institution where the applicant is registered in, the document must certify that the student status is expected to exist during the partial studies as well AND its translation
- translations must only be attached if the copy of the original document is not in the language of the selected study programme or in English

5) Research Plan:

- minimum 2 pages, typed in Times New Roman 12 point font size letters, written in the language of the selected study programme. The work plan must indicate the resources used, the document is checked by the universities for plagiarism.

6) Letter of Recommendation:

- a signed Letter of Recommendation from the applicant's former or current academic tutor or supervisor, who has a scientific degree and has an insight into the professional work of the applicant, the letter of recommendation must be written in the language of the selected study programme or in Hungarian.

7) Statement of the Supervisor (if required by the proposed Doctoral School, see section 2.3.) (ver documento convocatoria):

- a statement by the supervisor at the proposed Host Institution declaring that the supervisor undertakes to supervise the student's work within the doctoral programme (if required by the doctoral school).
- the Statement of the Supervisor (if required) must be uploaded until 15 March 2026.
- declaration is required to be uploaded until 15 January 2026 (if the Doctoral School requires a Statement of Supervisor).

8) Transcript of Records and its translations in the language of the selected study programme or Hungarian:

- copy of the original transcript of records regarding all academic semesters or school years completed during previous studies (in the highest level of education that the student has participated in) AND its translations.
- translations must only be attached if the copy of the original document is not in the language of the selected study programme or Hungarian.

9) Copy of Identification Document:

- provided that the applicant already has a passport, a scanned copy of the passport's data page should be uploaded.

- in case the applicant does not yet have a passport, they should upload a scanned copy of their national ID card.
- the page must be uploaded that contains both the personal data and the photograph of the applicant.

10) Acceptance of Statement for Application in the online system:

- all applicants need to read and accept the "Statement for Application" (please see Annex 2 for a sample)
- the statement can only be accepted in the online system, therefore scanned and signed copies should not be uploaded
- the statement appears in the online application system after registration
- all applicants need to click on accepting it to be able to submit their applications.

11) Medical Certificate:

- Mandatory only for those who will receive a scholarship. We strongly advise that nominated applicants start this process on time (after receiving the result of the nomination).
- the medical certificates of satisfactory health condition must be issued and signed by a physician to declare the medical condition of the applicant (according to the diseases listed on the form). The template describes the attachments that are required to be presented.
- the certificate must be recently issued. It means that the date of issue on the document cannot be earlier than 1 November 2025. page 14 / 27
- Scholarship holders should not upload the certificate to the online system, but they must bring it to Hungary and present it along with the attachments during the compulsory medical examination in Hungary.

B) Additional Documents for Art and Music Applicants

Besides the documents listed in Section 3.2.1, (ver documento convocatoria) applicants applying for Arts and/or Music studies must also upload the following documents. Art and Music applicants must submit the following documents via the online application system by 15 January 2026, 2 p.m.

It is very important to check the specific requirements of the particular study programme(s) about the portfolio. The type and number of the works that should be uploaded is set by the Host Institution, as well as the required file formats (photographs, audio or video files, etc). Applicants can check this information by clicking on the name of the study programme in the online application system. If you have any questions about the portfolio requirement, please contact the Host Institution. The file(s) have to be submitted in the Media Files section of the online application form. Please note that only files with a maximum size of 4 MB can be uploaded to the system. If the size of the art portfolio or the audio portfolio is larger than 4 MB, please upload a document containing the link(s) from which the portfolio file(s) can be downloaded.

C) Additional documents for self-financed applicants who wish to continue their studies as a scholarship holder

Those applicants who are registered self-financed / fee-paying students of a Hungarian higher education institution at the time of the application deadline AND who are now re-applying for the same study level are only eligible to apply for the Stipendium Hungaricum programme in cases listed in Section 2.2. (ver documento convocatoria) about non-eligibility.

Apart from the requirements about the average performance of the applicant, they need to be recommended by the Hungarian host universities where they are studying at the time of application. Therefore, we recommend that all of these applicants contact their universities and discuss whether the university wishes to recommend them for the scholarship. If you are recommended, please request a recommendation letter from the Hungarian Host Institution and upload it to the online application system by 15 March 2026.

D) Missing Documents

All documents listed in Section 3.2. (ver documento convocatoria) are mandatory application documents. However, certain documents are accepted to be uploaded even after the application deadline, provided that the applicant cannot obtain the document by the application deadline.

In this case, the applicants must upload a signed declaration stating that they will obtain and upload the missing document(s) by 1 August 2026 at the latest. Please note that Tempus Public Foundation provides no form for the declaration; it must be written by the applicant. No missing document will be accepted if the declaration is not uploaded by 15 January 2026, 2 p.m. and/or if the missing documents are not uploaded by 1 August 2026; thus, such applications will be rejected automatically.

The following missing documents can be submitted after the application deadline but no later than 1 August 2026.

Which documents can be uploaded as missing documents?

1- School certificates and their translations

i) high school certificate

- Who can upload these documents as missing documents? only applicants registered for the last semester of their secondary school studies
- What must be uploaded until 15 January 2026, 2 p.m. -declaration signed by the applicant
- What has to be uploaded until 1 August 2026 (TBC)? high school graduation certificate

ii) bachelor degree certificate

- Who can upload these documents as missing documents? only applicants registered for the last semester of their bachelor programme
- What has to be uploaded until 15 January 2026, 2 p.m - declaration signed by the applicant AND high school certificate and translation

- What has to be uploaded until 1 August 2026 (TBC)? bachelor degree certificate

iii) master degree certificate

- Who can upload these documents as missing documents? only applicants registered for the last semester of their master programme
